Dear Motoring Enthusiast:

The Hilton Head Island Concours d'Elegance & Motoring Festival will stage its Ninth Annual event this fall November 6 & 7, 2010. This year will feature Chevrolet as the Honored Marque and will include classes for Pre and Post War full-sized Chevrolets and an anniversary class for Corvair's 50th Anniversary. Additional special anniversary classes will also include the 50th Anniversary of Jaguar E-Class and 100th Anniversary of Alfa Romeo. Dr. Gerald Greenfield will serve as this year's Chief Judge. Both a preliminary Schedule of Events and the **proposed** Class Listing for 2010 are enclosed.

We would be pleased to *consider* your vehicle (**subject to review by our Selection Committee**) for inclusion if manufactured in 1972 or earlier and not shown at the Hilton Head Island Concours in 2008 or 2009.

There is no fee for participating in either Concours d'Elegance, a judged event on Sunday, November 7, or the Motoring Midway, an un-judged, two-day exhibit, Saturday and Sunday, November 6 & 7. Exhibitors will receive two Exhibitors Badges which will serve as complimentary entry for both Saturday and Sunday's (Nov. 6 & 7) events at the Coastal Discovery Museum at Honey Horn. Additionally, exhibitors will receive two passes into the Concours d'Elegance VIP Lounge to be located at the Discovery House on property where they and their guest will be served a continental breakfast and lunch on Sunday. The Marriott Resort & Spa will serve as the official host hotel.
